WAH, JDL

Makes a technical amendment to the scope of relief provided to native Hawaiians under Hawaiian home lands individual trust claims law.

SB 1030

RELATING TO BURIAL SITES.

WAH, WAM

Requires the department of land and natural resources to map burial sites that are inadvertently discovered using a global positioning system device and record the location of the site and the site to which

the remains are reinterred, if any, keeping the relocation site

confidential except as to lineal or cultural descendants. Appropriates

\$176,000 for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for staff and equipment

necessary to fulfill these requirements.
