SB 1943 SD1	RELATING TO ENERGY. Allows biofuel processing facilities to be a permitted use in an agriculture district. Establishes an energy feedstock program to develop a baseline percentage of energy feedstock to be grown in the State. (SD1)	ENE/TIA, WAH
