HB 1646 HD1 (HSCR476)	RELATING TO PESTICIDES. Requires retailers of pesticides to post signs informing consumers of the proper handling, storage, and disposal of pesticides and information regarding poisoning from the pesticides. Requires the department of agriculture to adopt rules to regulate the signs.	EEP/AGR, CPC

HB 936 HD1 (HSCR447)	RELATING TO GIFT CERTIFICATES. Prohibits a gift certificate issuer from charging service fees for dormancy or inactivity within 24 months after date of issuance of the certificate. Requires disclosure of fees on electronic card or certificate. (Deferred from 02/21/07 hearing agenda.)	EDB, CPC
HB 1456 HD1 (HSCR274)	RELATING TO PSYCHOLOGISTS. Establishes a means under state law by which appropriately trained and supervised psychologists practicing at federally qualified health centers or clinics in medically underserved or a mental health professional shortage areas may prescribe a limited formulary of psychotropic medications. (Deferred from 02/14/07 hearing agenda.)	HLT, CPC
HB 1577 HD1 (HSCR99)	RELATING TO GENETICALLY MODIFIED COFFEE. Temporarily prohibits the growing of genetically modified coffee. Allows research on genetically modified coffee in environmentally secure facilities. (Deferred from 02/21/07 hearing agenda.)	EEP, CPC
HB 1627	RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS. Makes technical and conforming amendments that relate to the recodified condominium law. (Deferred from 02/14/07 decision making only agenda.)	CPC
