HB 200 HD1 RELATING TO THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF

Adopts July 1997 DBEDT and DOH joint Inventory of Hawaii Greenhouse Gas Emissions Estimates for 1990. Requires DOH, with the assistance of DBEDT, to develop a comprehensive clean air plan with respect to greenhouse gas emissions exceeding US goals in the

Kyoto protocol.

HB 644

RELATING TO A BIOENERGY MASTER PLAN.

EEP, FIN

Establishes a bioenergy master plan task force to develop and

implement policies and procedures for a bioenergy industry in Hawaii.

Makes appropriations.
