HB 1 HD1 (HSCR156)	RELATING TO A COMPREHENSIVE OFFENDER REENTRY SYSTEM. Establishes comprehensive offender reentry system to assist adult offenders with preparing for release and reintegration back into the community. Appropriates funds.	PSM/LAB, FIN
HB 195 HD1 (HSCR5)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII CIVIL AIR PATROL. Appropriates funds for the Hawaii Civil Air Patrol.	PSM, FIN
HB 201 (HSCR452)	RELATING TO STATE VETERANS' HOME. Establishes a veterans' home account and veterans' gift account to be administered by the Hawaii health systems corporation for the state veterans' home in Hilo. Also requires accounts to comply with reporting requirements for non-general fund information.	PSM, FIN
HB 1605 (HSCR301)	RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL. Appropriates funds for the design of a Maui traffic control center.	TRN, FIN
HB 1447 HD1 (HSCR563)	RELATING TO NOISE. Establishes a noise abatement zone for motor vehicles and mopeds and assesses an escalating fine starting at \$100 and impoundment of vehicles for transgressors. Effective date of July 1, 2051.	TRN, JUD, FIN
HB 724 (HSCR299)	RELATING TO COUNTY SURCHARGE ON STATE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. Reduces annual reimbursement by city and county of Honolulu to the State from gross proceeds of the county's surcharge on the general excise tax from 10% to 5% or \$5,000,000, whichever is less.	TRN, FIN


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
