HB 159	RELATING TO VOCATIONAL TRAINING. Appropriates funds for the establishment of post-high school vocational education programs in Pahoia and Ka'u, in the county of Hawaii.	HED/LAB, FIN
HB 1011	RELATING TO UNIFORM INFORMATION PRACTICES. Requires the public disclosure of proposed compensation or compensation changes for administrative positions in the University of Hawaii system.	HED/LAB, JUD
HB 1012	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Provides funding to the University of Hawaii to design, research, and develop an interactive searchable web-base database.	HED/LAB, FIN

HB 1013 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPERIENTIAL HED/LAB, FIN
LEARNING.
Appropriation to the University of Hawaii; \$75,000 for research and development of a statewide web-based database of experiential learning opportunities; \$10,000 for study to identify barriers to businesses and organizations volunteering to provide experiential learning opportunities to K-12 and post-secondary learners.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Please provide 35 copies for each of the following bills:

HB 1869 RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. HED, FIN
Requires the net general fund appropriation to the University of Hawaii for each fiscal year to be at least 10% of the total general fund appropriation to the executive branch.

HB 953 RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION. HED, FIN
Establishes and appropriates funds for a textbook lending library program at each UH community college to assist students in need.

HB 586 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HED, FIN
HAWAII.
Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii for distance training in public health.

HB 1533 RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION. HED, FIN
Appropriates funds for additional positions to support a joint effort between the University of Hawaii at Manoa College of Education and Leeward Community College to recruit, train, and retain more teachers.


