Thursday, April 5, 2018

The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, convened at 12:03 o'clock p.m., with Speaker Saiki presiding.

"Mr. Speaker, same request, brief comment. Mr. Speaker, this is kind of like picking on the small guy. The small guy in the sense that it's a huge department with a small budget. We have over a million square miles of land, a million square miles of ocean. Unless they've really done something incorrectly, auditing them is a little bit of a damning with faint praise, and paying attention to them on something that otherwise may not be very important. But it's a huge responsibility that DLNR has, and a very, very strained budget. So for those reasons, Mr. Speaker, a no vote."

Representative Tupola rose to speak in support of both measures, stating:

"In support. Real quick, I do know that it's a big department, the most land rich, cash poor, and I do know that harming or creating extra things for a small department to do is not desirable. However, some of the programs, and a lot of them are actually out in our area, especially if you have a lot of ag in your district, there's always room for improvement, and there's quite a few things that I think we would like to see to be improved, especially their approaches towards some of the community initiatives that we've been having a really hard time with the department on. So I think it could be a positive thing, both for the agency as well as for the community. Thank you."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the reports of the Committee were adopted and H.R.
