The House of Representatives of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, convened at 11:36 o'clock a.m., with Vice Speaker Nakashima presiding.

The invocation was delivered by Mr. Carswell Ross, after which the Roll was called showing all Members present with the exception of Representatives Lowen, McKelvey, Nakamura, Quinlan and Tokioka, who were excused.

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I'm rising to cast a no vote on Senate Concurrent Resolution 133 and I'd like to make a few comments. Thank you. Mr. Speaker, these measures, there's several of them on the agenda today authorizing issuance of leases covering our shoreline areas, it's very ironic, Mr. Speaker, that these measures are before us today after we have had such a devastating flooding of our coastal areas and even some inland areas, particularly on the island of Kauai. Mr. Speaker, they say a picture is worth a thousand words, and I have a picture here of a dwelling that has been swept away, and I was going to pass that around to members to take a look at it. There are many more pictures, of course, on the internet, of the devastation that has occurred.

"Mr. Speaker, there's also a headline, front-page article today in the Star Advertiser titled 'Erosion is eating away at Hawaii's shorelines.' And we, instead of recognizing that and instead of doing maybe piece by piece management, we are just going ahead and issuing all of these leases covering submerged lands and portions of state submerged land, *et cetera*, as we have these measures before us.

"I think it's time, Mr. Speaker, to stop doing this in this body and to recognize that we are faced with sea level rise, and to recognize the problems that we have to address in a more sensible way, in a management way, rather than just going ahead and issuing these easements and continuing to do that.

"I'd like to read a couple of quotes from Dr. Chip Fletcher, University of Hawaii, he is one of the most knowledgeable people in the state about sea level rise. Dr. Fletcher says, 'Look at our beaches on any weekend. They are crowded with families. Beaches belong to our children. We are caretakers. If we keep building sea walls and destroying this legacy, we deserve to be known as a generation of thieves.' And Mr. Speaker, he goes on to say, 'We know sea level is rising. We know the shoreline is going to recede and move landward. In my opinion it's our job to get out of the way.'

"Mr. Speaker, these measures do not let us get out of the way. These measures really are denial of what is happening to our island shores, and I'm casting a no vote on all of them. So I will stand up individually, because there are some good measures interspersed in between the ones that are refusing to acknowledge that we need to get out of the way. Thank you."

> Subject: Grant of Term, Non-Exclusive Easement for Seawall Steps and Landscaped Area Purposes Seaward of Tax Map Key (TMK) 8-7-023: 044

This is in response to your request, received September 1, 2017, for comments on the subject Project. We understand the Applicant seeks a grant of term, non-exclusive easement for a seawall that is approximately 353 square feet. The seawall is make if of the property line and is therefore in the State Land Use (SLU) Conservation District. The site mauka of the property line is within the SLU Urban District and the County's R-5 Residential District. We have the following comments:

The seawall fronting the subject site is listed as nonconforming in our seawall inventory. However, portions of the wood and chain-link fences shown in the photos appear to be within the SLU Urban District. Photographs of the shoreline from 1986 and 1989 do not show these structures and we do not have any record that they were authorized as minor shoreline structures. Therefore, we recommend that the Applicant be required to remove the fences and any other unauthorized structures from the shoreline setback. Once a certified shoreline survey is issued, the Applicant may seek a Minor Shoreline Structure Permit to allow a 50-percent open work fence within the shoreline setback.

According to the application documents, the dwelling unit on the site was destroyed by fire and has been completely removed. The Applicant should be aware that any work that me that the definition of 'development' for purposes of the Special Management Area (SMA) Ordinance (Chapter 25, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu (ROH)) (i.e., work that is not part of the development of a new single-family dwelling that is less than 7,500 square feet of floor area) will require an SMA Permit. At this time, it appears no work is proposed on the seawall structure. Therefore, no SMA permit is required at this time.
