

## THIRTY-SIXTH DAY

Thursday, March 10, 1977

The Senate of the Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1977, convened at 11:30 o'clock a.m., with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Reverend Ruth Senter of the Waialua United Church of Christ, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Hulten who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Soares introduced to the members of the Senate Student Government officers from Pearl City High School, Kaimuki High School, Nanakuli High School, Waialua High School, Iolani High School and Roosevelt High School.

## MESSAGES FROM THE GOVERNOR
