Thursday, March 21, 1991

The Senate of the Sixteenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1991, convened at 11:40 o'clock a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Mr. Toni Pelle, member of the Hawaii National Bahai'i Association, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Chang, McCartney and Wong who were excused.

The Chair announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Fifth Day.

We received testimonies during the hearing on an identical Senate bill which was recommitted. We would like to expedite the decision-making so the bill can be acted upon."

The Chair granted the waiver.
