# Friday, March 22, 1991

The Senate of the Sixteenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1991, convened at 11:38 o'clock a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Father Franklin Pao of St. Louis School after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Mizuguchi who was excused.

The Chair announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Sixth Day.

The following introductions were made to the members of the Senate:

Senator Tungpalan, on behalf of Senators Iwase, Crozier and herself, introduced a group of 4th grade students from Waipahu Elementary School and their teachers, Mrs. Corian Kajikawa, Mrs. Nora Saito, Ms. Christine Ng and Mr. Tad Iwami, all of whom were seated in the gallery.

Senator Tungpalan also introduced her daughter Lori, also seated in the gallery, who is home from school for the spring break.

Senator Yamasaki, on behalf of Senators Solomon, Reed and himself, introduced Mr. and Mrs. Charles Dapitan of Maui who were also seated in the gallery.

Senator Nakasato then introduced his student "shadows," Cory Oliveros, James Greubel, Carrie Ching and Lindi Chun, 8th grade students from Moanalua Intermediate School, seated in the gallery.

Senator McMurdo then introduced her "very dear friends from Texas," Elladean Chambers, who was a sorority sister, and husband Chuck. The Chambers and their friends, who were seated in the gallery, are participants of an elder hostel program at the University of Hawaii.

Senator McMurdo also introduced Dr. Donnis H. Thompson, who was seated on the floor of the Senate, as follows:

"Today, it gives me great pleasure to present this particular certificate of appreciation to a very outstanding woman.

"Dr. Donnis H. Thompson, long recognized as a major force in the organization and promotion of women's athletics in the State of Hawaii, is honored for her outstanding contributions to sports, academics, and the community. Her distinctive career in Hawaii began in 1961 as a health and physical education professor at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.

"As part of her classroom teaching, Dr. Thompson introduced progressive and innovative programs into the curriculum, and encouraged students to organize and supervise athletics-related community activities.

"After serving as the interim director of women's athletics for three years, Donnis then became the women's athletic director at the University of Hawaii in '76. During her tenure, Dr. Thompson set new standards for excellence within the athletic department and the University, and shaped the program from one that was virtually nonexistent to one that now receives national and international recognition. Most notably, Dr. Thompson

coached a world-class women's track team at the University of Hawaii.

"In 1981, Dr. Thompson was appointed by Governor Ariyoshi to serve as the superintendent of the Department of Education. Dr. Thompson's vision and leadership provided the foundation for the establishment of many important programs.

"In addition to her many years of public service with the Department of Education and the University of Hawaii, Dr. Thompson has been active in numerous and diverse community service programs. Some of the organizations for which she has selflessly volunteered include the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Governor's Interim Commission, the State Commission on Civil Rights, Advisory Committee to the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, the American Cancer Society, Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children, the YWCA, the Honolulu Meditation Center, and the U.S. Council Sports Committee.

"Dr. Thompson has been recognized by her peers, community organizations, and the government for her never-ending enthusiasm and compassion, her progressive ideas, and her selfless dedication to everything she undertakes. She is a true leader, and her talents are greatly appreciated by all who know her.

"It gives me great pleasure to introduce our honoree, Dr. Donnis H. Thompson. Next to Donnis is Kalani Dapitan. This young gentleman is Dr. Thompson's Godson and he is a student at Iao Intermediate School on Maui. And next to him is Mr. Artie McNair, who has been a close friend and companion of Dr. Thompson since 1962. He is a retired U.S. government employee."

Dr. Thompson rose to be recognized and was presented the Senate certificate of appreciation by Senator McMurdo. Senator Iwase presented her with a lei. Mr. McNair and Kalani also rose to be recognized and were presented leis by Senators Ikeda and Tungpalan.

Senator McMurdo also introduced a group of friends of Dr. Thompson who were seated in the gallery: Jan and Charlie Dapitan, parents of Kalani; Marsha and Kenneth Joiner; and Fay Kennedy Bailey.

Senator Reed also rose to recognize and extend his greetings and aloha to the Dapitan family.

At 11:51 o'clock a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.

## **RE-REFERRAL OF HOUSE BILL**

The Chair re-referred H.B. No. 1016, H.D. 1, jointly to the Committee on Judiciary and the Committee on Transportation and Intergovernmental Relations.

Senator Tungpalan rose to speak on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Mr. President, yesterday when I greeted my daughter at the airport she told me that she was having a chance to really know what Hawaii was all about again, through ads that aired in California. She mentioned that some of the very good ads implored employers to give their employees time off to spend some time here in Hawaii and that they will go back as productive workers. But she did mention that some ads were a little on the 'coconut bra' side; and in fact, you know, it's no wonder that people were asking her, 'What, you have cars in Hawaii? You mean you don't travel in canoes?'

"So, we can do a better job, I think, of promoting commercials like the one that encourages employers to

give their employees time off and perhaps even like the one my daughter said she saw on American Airlines. Before landing in Honolulu, they had a five-minute presentation of what Hawaii was all about. She said that was very representative of Hawaii. I'd like to commend the media campaigns that put together the American Airlines ad as well as the other one encouraging employers to give their workers time off. In fact, it did get one worker here. My sister, you recall, was here last week. She had heard one of those ads and she got on the airplane. She told her employer, 'You know, I'll be a more productive citizen.' It did work at least for our family. Thank you very much."

Senator Cobb, also on a point of personal privilege, said:

"Mr. President, if there's anything that the HVB and other lobbyists should have learned by now is that 'coconut bras' and plastic dinosaurs do not go over very well in the Senate. And please, I urge them to keep that in mind in the future. Thank you."
