

## FIFTY-THIRD DAY

Thursday, April 21, 1994

The Senate of the Seventeenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1994, convened at 11:37 o'clock a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Colonel Kenneth Beason, Senior Chaplain, Hickam Air Force Base, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Chang, Nakasato and Reed who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Fifty-Second Day.

Senator Matsunaga, with the assistance of Senators Kanno, Baker, Fernandes Salling, Solomon and Levin, introduced the winners of the 1994 Small Business Person of the Year Awards for the State of Hawaii. Each of the guests received a Senate certificate and a lei by various Senators.

At 11:53 o'clock a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.

The Senate reconvened at 12:01 o'clock p.m.

## MESSAGE FROM THE GOVERNOR
