The Chair having so ordered, Senator Baker's remarks read as follows:

"Madam President, I rise in support of SB1096 SD1 HD2 CD1, Relating to On-Bill Programs.

"This administration bill is a priority of the Public Utilities Commission. It exempts electric utilities serving as billing and collection agents in a purely pass-through capacity for on-bill financing and repayment programs from certain state and county taxes and financial regulations.

"This measure would benefit consumers. On-bill programs administered by an electric utility allow customers to purchase a renewable energy system while the utility serves as a billing and collecting agent. Electric utilities that are functioning in this 'pass-through' capacity for on-bill financing and repayment programs are not raising revenue from the monies collected and remitted. Levying revenue-related taxes on them or imposing other financial regulations creates additional costs for the utilities, which could then be passed on to ratepayers. This measure eliminates these additional costs.

"I urge my colleagues to join me in supporting the passage of SB1096 SD1 HD2 CD1."

Senator Baker rose to request that remarks in support of the measure be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered.

The Chair having so ordered, Senator Baker's remarks read as follows:

"Madam President, I rise in strong support of HB858 HD2 SD2 CD1, Relating to Domestic Violence.

"This measure will help protect victims of domestic violence, making it easier for them to leave an abuser. HB858 CD1 permits early termination of a residential rental agreement in cases of domestic violence.

"Feeling safe in your own home is not a reality for victims of domestic violence. Being locked into a lease may prevent a victim from leaving an abuser. Many victims are under the financial control of abusers and may be unable to pay fees or other associated penalties that could come with ending or exciting a rental agreement. These penalties and fees create added barriers to the already difficult task of getting out of an abusive relationship.

"HB858 CD1 enables victims of domestic violence to terminate residential rental agreements and specifies procedures under the residential landlord-tenant code for instances of domestic violence.

"The issue of housing is critical for domestic violence victims. I urge my colleagues to join me in supporting HB858 CD1."

Senator Baker rose to request that remarks in support of the measure be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered.

The Chair having so ordered, Senator Baker's remarks read as follows:

"Madam President, I rise in support of HB1075 HD2 SD2 CD1, Relating to Health.

"This measure authorizes the Hawai'i Health Systems Corporation to negotiate an agreement to partner with a private entity to create and transition to a new non-profit entity to manage, operate and staff the health care facilities of the Maui Region. Those facilities are Maui Memorial Medical Center, Kula Hospital and Lanai Community Hospital. This measure was developed collaboratively and is the culmination of several years of work. It reflects the consensus from the community, administration and legislative leaders that the current operating model does not work and is not sustainable in this current, reimbursement challenged healthcare climate. The bill creates a new operating model to enable Maui Region to maintain and deliver high quality healthcare to our residents and visitors. This bill addresses community concerns about keeping quality

healthcare services on Maui and provides protection for the employees affected by the transfer from public to private employment. Impacts bargaining for the affected employees will be undertaken and jobs will be maintained during the transition. Both Hawaii Pacific Health and Kaiser Permanente Hawaii have expressed interest in partnering with the Maui Region to improve health care in Maui County.

“Maui Memorial Medical Center is an important part of our Maui Community. It delivers top-rated hospital and emergency care to many, including visitors who vacation on Maui. Without a quality hospital, our visitor industry and our economy would suffer. Without MMMC, the people of Maui would have limited options and might have to fly to O‘ahu for acute care services or do without. However, O‘ahu hospitals often operate at capacity and would be negatively impacted if MMMC lost its ability to provide acute and tertiary care service. MMMC plays an important role to the other neighbor islands as well, since patients fly to Maui for trauma, stroke and cardiac care.

“Ranked among the top hospitals in the nation this spring, receiving an ‘A’ grade in the Hospital Safety category, MMMC provides high quality healthcare to its patients. But, Maui Memorial also loses money and operates in deficit, relying on ever-shrinking state subsidies from year to year. Already, MMMC has eliminated in-patient adolescent psychiatric services and has been forced to begin the process to consider cutting additional services in order to keep its doors open. Cutting services vital to the health and safety of our community will create a robust hospital and will negatively impact the quality of life of all of us. Unfortunately, the Executive budget cannot provide the appropriate level of resources to maintain the 24/7 services the Maui Community needs and deserves. This measure gives us hope. It will help to ensure that MMMC will be able to continue to provide essential, vital services to our community.

“I urge my colleagues to join me in supporting this important measure. Mahalo for your aye vote.”
