HB 2098 HD1 RELATING TO CRIMINAL HISTORY EDN, JHA
(HSCR 441-00) Requires private schools, in cooperation with the Hawaii criminal justice data center, to conduct criminal history verifications of applicants for employment in positions necessitating close proximity to children. (HB2098 HD1)

HB 2583 HD1 RELATING TO OPEN MEETINGS EDB, JHA
(HSCR 267-00) Requiring that board meeting notices specify that the public may attend videoconferenced board meetings at any of the specified meeting locations. (HB2583 HD1)

RECONSIDERATION OF PRIOR DECISION-MAKING:

HB 2634 RELATING TO NO CANDIDATES FILED FOR AN ELECTIVE OFFICE JHA
Allows for the candidate filing deadline to be extended if there are no candidates filed for office at the close of candidate filing.

HB 1758 HD1 RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER LICENSING TRN, JHA
(HSCR 10-00) Gives the department of transportation an additional year to effectuate Act 175, SLH 1999 (which provides for a statewide driver education program and behind-the-wheel driver training program), with an exception for the date which section 2. subsection (b) takes effect.

HB 2649 RELATING TO NONCONSENSUAL COMMON LAW LIENS JHA
Requires nonconsensual common law liens to designate whether they are directed at a public officer or employee.

BILLS ORIGINALLY HEARD ON 02/24/00

HB 2388 HD1 RELATING TO EDUCATION EDN, JHA
(HSCR 191-00) Extends the department of education's zero tolerance policy toward dangerous weapons, switchblade knives, intoxicating liquor, and illicit drugs to include department supervised activities on or off school property, and activities that occur on school premises and during the school day. (HB2388 HD1)

HB 2732 RELATING TO COURT REPORTERS JHA
Imposes requirements on private court reporters. Provides for civil fine for violations.

HB 2891 RELATING TO COMBATIVE SPORTS JHA
Prohibits persons from holding, promoting, advancing, profiting from, or participating in a combative sport. Civil and criminal penalties are provided.


HB 2441 RELATING TO BIOLOGICAL MATERIALS EDB, JHA
(HSCR 90-00) Defines "biological materials" and provides for the recognition of biological materials as personal property.
