Pursuant to Act 242, relating to Uniform Information Practices, on January 6, 2002, you were advised that in the year 2002 no police officers in the Department were suspended or discharged for conduct involving 1) malicious use of physical force, 2) mistreatment of prisoners, 3) use and or possession of drugs and narcotics, or 4) cowardice.

At this date we are providing a summary of all incidents and violations which resulted in the suspension or discharge of Police Officers from January 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002. It should be noted that although the incidents are listed separately, several officers may be involved in a single incident and an officer may have been involved in several of the twenty-one (21) incidents listed. Also discipline imposed may be progressive whereby the prior disciplinary histories of the individuals are considered.
