9 SECTION 1. Section 652-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 repealed.

11 ~~["§652-14 Receipts to be given by creditor on penalty of~~
12 ~~forfeiture. Any creditor collecting money under garnishment~~
13 ~~process shall furnish duplicate receipts therefor to the~~
14 ~~garnishee, one of which receipts shall be delivered by the~~
15 ~~garnishee to the debtor.~~

16 ~~No portion of any salary or wages withheld or sequestered~~




