A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Except as otherwise provided, the superintendent
4 shall sign all drafts for the payment of moneys, all commissions
5 and appointments, all deeds, official acts, or other documents
6 of the department. The superintendent may use a printed
7 facsimile signature in approving appointments, contracts, and
8 other documents. [~~The superintendent, at such time as may be
9 prescribed by the board, shall present to the board full annual
10 reports of the principal transactions within the department
11 during the last completed year, which reports together with such
12 recommendations as the board may think proper, shall be
13 presented to the governor and the legislature.~~]"

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.




