# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 490:3-506.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,  
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§490:3-506.5[+] Charges for dishonored checks. The  
4 payee or a holder in due course of any check, draft, or order  
5 for the payment of money that has been dishonored for lack of  
6 funds or credit to pay the check, draft, or order or because the  
7 maker has no account with the drawee shall be allowed to assess  
8 the maker a reasonable service charge of not more than [~~\$20-~~  
9 \$30."]

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
