
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL RIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 489-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
3 and to read as follows:

4 "Sexual orientation" means having a preference for
5 heterosexuality, homosexuality, or bisexuality, having a history
6 of any one or more of these preferences, or being identified
7 with any one or more of these preferences. "Sexual orientation"
8 shall not be construed to protect conduct otherwise proscribed
9 by law."

10 SECTION 2. Section 489-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 **"§489-3 Discriminatory practices prohibition.** Unfair
13 discriminatory practices [~~which~~] that deny, or attempt to deny,
14 a person the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services,
15 facilities, privileges, advantages, and accommodations of a
16 place of public accommodation on the basis of race, sex, sexual
17 orientation, color, religion, ancestry, or disability are
18 prohibited."



- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
