
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE RULES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Each agency adopting, amending, or repealing a rule,
4 upon approval thereof by the governor or the mayor of the
5 county, shall file forthwith certified copies thereof with the
6 lieutenant governor in the case of the State, including two
7 certified copies, respectively, with the clerk of the Hawaii
8 state senate and clerk of the Hawaii state house of
9 representatives, or with the clerk of the county in the case of
10 a county. In addition, the clerks of all of the counties shall
11 file forthwith certified copies thereof with the lieutenant
12 governor. A permanent register of the rules, open to public
13 inspection, shall be kept by the lieutenant governor and the
14 clerks of the counties[~~-~~], the state senate, and the state house
15 of representatives."
16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2096.

Administrative Rules; Legislative Clerks' Office

Description:

Requires any state agency adopting, amending, or repealing an administrative rule to file two certified copies of the rule with clerk of the senate and of the house of representatives, respectively, at the time of filing the rule with the lieutenant governor. (HB1844 HD1)
