
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE CONDEMNATION OF LAND IN
NANAKULI, OAHU, FOR A PUBLIC HOUSING PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Leeward Land LLC owns a parcel of real property
2 in Nanakuli, Oahu, comprised of one hundred seventy-two acres,
3 commonly known as the Nanakuli B site. The legislature finds
4 that the parcel is suitable and desirable for the development of
5 a public housing project. The legislature further finds that
6 the condemnation of the parcel for a public housing project is
7 for a public purpose.

8 SECTION 2. The Hawaii public housing administration is
9 directed to commence eminent domain proceedings, pursuant to
10 section 201G-16, for the condemnation of the Nanakuli B site for
11 a public housing project.

12 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
15 the condemnation of the Nanakuli B site, TMK: ,
16 comprising of one hundred seventy-two acres, more or less, for a
17 public housing project.

1 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
2 Hawaii public housing administration for the purposes of this
3 Act.

4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
