
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO IMPLEMENT ACT 112, SESSION LAWS OF
HAWAII, 2005.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the purpose of Act
2 112, Session Laws of Hawaii, 2005, was to enhance law
3 enforcement tools by establishing a statewide deoxyribonucleic
4 acid (DNA) database and date bank identification program for all
5 convicted felons. Expanding the DNA database helps to prevent
6 crimes, solve crimes through "cold hits", and assists in
7 exonerating wrongfully convicted people.

8 The legislature further finds that the legislature removed
9 funding authorization language from the final version of Act
10 112, Session Laws of Hawaii, 2005, hampering efforts to meet the
11 requirements of the Act. The purpose of this Act is to provide
12 the funding necessary to fully implement Act 112, Session Laws
13 of Hawaii, 2005.

14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the DNA registry
15 special fund the sum of \$, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, for fiscal year 2006-2007 to carry out the
17 purposes of this Act.
