
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RESTROOM FACILITIES FOR WOMEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The state shall provide at least twice as many
2 water closets for use by females as available to males at state
3 owned or operated facilities such as stadiums, auditoriums, and
4 international airports where a large number of the public
5 congregate.

6 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
7 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$_____, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
10 2006-2007 for the purpose of renovating state owned or operated
11 facilities to come into compliance with this Act.

12 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
13 department of accounting and general services for the purposes
14 of this Act.

15 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
16 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is

1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
