
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER'S EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~[+]§286-108.4~~ **Driver education and behind-the-wheel**
4 **driver training program.** ~~[+]~~ The director of transportation is
5 directed to ~~[establish]~~:

6 (1) Establish and certify a statewide driver education
7 program and behind-the-wheel driver training program,
8 to include the number of course hours, curriculum, and
9 certification of teachers and third-party examiners~~[-~~
10 ~~The director of transportation is also directed to~~
11 ~~set]~~;

12 (2) Set a cost for the programs to enable the programs to
13 be self-sufficient~~[-]~~; and

14 (3) Ensure that the program is available on the same basis
15 to every applicant to the program, including but not
16 limited to private school and home-schooled students.

17 The director of transportation shall adopt rules pursuant
18 to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this ~~[+]section[+]~~."



1 SECTION 2. Section 302A-413, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The department, for the purpose of this section,
4 shall:

- 5 (1) Set the prerequisites and priorities for enrollment in
6 the course of driver education and training, which
7 shall be open on the same basis to every resident of
8 the [~~State~~] state who is fifteen years of age or older
9 and under nineteen years of age^[+], including but not
10 limited to private school and home-schooled students;
- 11 (2) Establish the requirements for and employ necessary
12 instructors, who are certified to have completed
13 satisfactorily an approved instructor's course, to
14 conduct the course in driver education and training;
- 15 (3) Issue a certificate of completion to every student
16 upon satisfactory completion of the course in driver
17 education and training;
- 18 (4) Purchase, rent, or acquire by gift, materials and
19 equipment necessary for the program established by
20 this section; and
- 21 (5) Cooperate with the chief of police in each county in
22 promoting traffic safety."
