## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 to establish a rapid response emergency medical services unit,  
3 to include personnel, equipment, and operational expenses for a  
4 twenty-four hour, seven days a week, rapid response emergency  
5 medical services unit for the Mililani/Mililani Mauka area on  
6 Oahu.

7           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$600,000, or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to be  
10 deposited into the emergency medical services special fund.

11           SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency  
12 medical services special fund the sum of \$600,000, or so much  
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to  
14 establish a twenty-four hour, seven days a week, rapid response  
15 emergency medical services unit to serve the Mililani/Mililani  
16 Mauka area on Oahu.

17           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
18 health for the purpose of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
