# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 for a fully-capable, advanced life support emergency medical  
3 services ambulance unit that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day,  
4 seven-days-a-week emergency response service to the areas of  
5 Lower Mililani, Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu,  
6 Waiawa, and the Pearl City industrial area on Oahu.

7           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,300,000 or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be  
10 deposited into the emergency medical services special fund.

11           SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency  
12 medical services special fund the sum of \$1 or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to establish a  
14 fully-capable, advanced life support emergency medical services  
15 ambulance unit that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day, seven-  
16 days-a-week emergency response service to the areas of Lower  
17 Mililani, Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu,  
18 Waiawa, and the Pearl City industrial area on Oahu.



1           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
