
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH, FIFTEENTH, AND SIXTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE
DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007:

5 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and
6 general services:

7 A. Hanapepe library, Kauai

8 Construction for project completion to renovate
9 existing library.
