
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§150A-A Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
5 charge. (a) The department shall prescribe and collect a
6 schedule of service fees and charges for invasive species
7 inspection, quarantine, and eradication services from any person
8 who imports any article or means of conveyance. The department
9 shall establish a schedule of service fees and charges to ensure
10 that the service is commensurate with the costs of inspection,
11 quarantine, and eradication services.

12 (b) Any person who imports an article or means of
13 conveyance shall pay the appropriate service fee or charge to
14 the department before the article or means of conveyance is
15 moved from a port of entry in the State.

16 (c) If a person subject to a service fee or charge under
17 this section fails to pay the service fee or charge when due,
18 the department shall assess a late payment penalty.



1 (d) All service fees and charges collected by the
2 department under this section shall be deposited in the invasive
3 species inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund.

4 **§150A-B Invasive species inspection, quarantine, and**
5 **eradication fund.** (a) There is established in the state
6 treasury the invasive species inspection, quarantine, and
7 eradication fund, into which shall be deposited:

8 (1) Legislative appropriations for inspection and
9 quarantine services;

10 (2) Service fees and charges collected under section 150A-
11 A;

12 (3) Fees for permits and inspections;

13 (4) Fines and penalties collected for violations of this
14 chapter; and

15 (5) Federal funds received for inspection, quarantine, and
16 eradication programs.

17 (b) The moneys of the invasive species inspection,
18 quarantine, and eradication fund shall be used for the operation
19 of inspection and monitoring facilities at ports of entry and
20 the execution of emergency remedial measures when invasive
21 species are detected at ports of entry."



1 SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
3 inserted and to read as follows:

4 "Article" means any material or tangible object that could
5 harbor invasive species, including plants, plant products, soil,
6 boxes and containers, vehicles, baggage, or packing material
7 used in connection with the movement of plants, plant products,
8 or animals.

9 "Means of conveyance" means any personal property used for
10 or intended for use for the movement of any other personal
11 property."

12 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
13 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
14 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
15 the new sections in this Act.

16 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
