
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ETHANOL CONTENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 486J-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The commissioner shall adopt rules in accordance with
4 chapter 91 to require that gasoline sold in the [~~State~~] state
5 for use in motor vehicles contain ten per cent ethanol by
6 volume[-]; provided that the rules shall take effect on April 2,
7 2008. The amounts of gasoline sold in the [~~State~~] state
8 containing ten per cent ethanol shall be in accordance with
9 rules as the commissioner may deem appropriate. The
10 commissioner may authorize the sale of gasoline that does not
11 meet these requirements as provided in subsection (d)."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
