# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 178, Session  
2 Laws of Hawaii 2005, appropriated a total of \$10,000,000 for  
3 fiscal year 2005-2006 from the state highway fund to the city  
4 and county of Honolulu (\$4,000,000), the county of Hawaii  
5 (\$2,000,000), the county of Maui (\$2,000,000), and the county of  
6 Kauai (\$2,000,000), as subsidies for county road work. The  
7 legislature also finds that section 248-9, Hawaii Revised  
8 Statutes, authorizes the use of state highway fund moneys only  
9 for the state highway system. It does not authorize the use of  
10 such moneys for the road systems of the counties.

11           The purpose of this Act is to authorize the use of moneys  
12 from the state highway fund for the road systems of the counties  
13 for fiscal year 2005-2006.

14           SECTION 2. For fiscal year 2005-2006, moneys deposited in  
15 the state highway fund may be appropriated to and expended by  
16 the counties for the road system of the counties.

17           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2006.
