
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no
2 state or county agency, commission, corporation, or department,
3 or any other authority of the State or county shall expend any
4 federal funds provided by the United States Office for Domestic
5 Preparedness under the State Homeland Security Program, unless
6 the department of defense submits to the legislature:

7 (1) A detailed report on past, present, and planned future
8 expenditures of federal funds provided under the State
9 Homeland Security Program, including:

10 (A) The overall guidelines and strategy used in
11 determining funding priorities;

12 (B) All of the specific projects funded and planned
13 to be funded, and their respective funding
14 amounts; and

15 (C) The impact and measurable results of the funding;
16 and

17 (2) A homeland security plan that includes consideration
18 of the following priorities:



- 1 (A) Interoperable communications between first
2 responders of all government jurisdictions;
- 3 (B) Auditing program for radiation sources, in
4 collaboration with users of radioactive
5 materials, including hospitals, laboratories,
6 food irradiation, and industrial applications;
- 7 (C) Domestic intelligence gathering;
- 8 (D) Mass casualty planning;
- 9 (E) Transportation security, including ground
10 transportation and commercial and small boat
11 harbors;
- 12 (F) Chemical security, including security at waste
13 water treatment facilities; and
- 14 (G) Cyber security.

15 The homeland security plan shall include objectives, cost
16 assessments, and schedules and timelines for completion of the
17 plan's components. If the legislature is not in session, the
18 department of defense shall submit copies of the detailed report
19 and the homeland security plan to the speaker of the house of
20 representatives and the president of the senate.

21 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
