
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for
4 the chief election officer to provide voter registration and
5 voter information and educational material in printed and
6 electronic formats in any language deemed appropriate by the
7 chief election officer.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
9 elections for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
