
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE
TWENTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


