# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 88-73, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) Any [~~member of the legislature~~] elective officer who  
4 attains age sixty-five may retire and receive a service  
5 retirement allowance although the [~~member~~] elective officer  
6 continues to fill the elective position."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
