
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A PURCHASE OF SERVICE TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, as a
4 purchase of service pursuant to chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised
5 Statutes, for the department of health to enter into a purchase
6 of services with ARC in Hawaii for the purpose of operating
7 domiciliary homes and apartment complexes for the
8 developmentally disabled.

9 SECTION 2. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
10 department of health for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
