
A BILL FOR AN ACT

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR BRIDGE SIGNS ON HANA HIGHWAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for signs
4 identifying each of the bridges on the Hana highway, state
5 routes 36 and 360.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
7 transportation for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
