
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTY-
FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007.

5 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and general
6 services:

7 A. Boys and Girls Club of Hawaii,
8 Nanakuli, Oahu.

9 Design, construction and equipment for
10 the Boys and Girls Club of Hawaii, club
11 house in Nanakuli with matching funds
12 from private foundations, individuals,
13 and federal grants.

5 drains). This project is to include
6 the restoring of the softball field and
7 construction of two dugouts.
