## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE WAIANAE COST COMPREHENSIVE  
HEALTH CENTER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Waianae Coast  
2 Comprehensive Health Center serves a population of forty  
3 thousand people in Leeward, Oahu. It has a twenty-four-hour  
4 emergency room and only one ambulance. The nearest back up  
5 emergency services are twenty miles away at Saint Francis-West.

6           Emergency services at the Waianae Coast Comprehensive  
7 Health Center have received legislative appropriations since  
8 1976. Without this legislative support, the Waianae Coast  
9 Comprehensive Health Center emergency room would have to close  
10 its doors.

11           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for  
12 emergency services at the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health  
13 Center.

14           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$           , or so  
16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for



1 emergency services at the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health  
2 Center.

3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the  
4 department of health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
