
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE TWENTY-THIRD REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
4 following capital improvements in the twenty-third
5 representative district:

6 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and general
7 services.

8 A. Manoa and makiki streams
9 Topographic and hydrologic survey \$

10 B. Palolo flood control concrete channel
11 Engineering study to determine life
12 expectancy of channel \$

13 C. Upper Manoa and Waikiki
14 Design of a bikeway and pedestrian path

16 the stream corridor \$

17 D. Manoa stream



13 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
14 improvement projects authorized in this Act, shall not lapse at
15 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
16 made; provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as
17 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
19 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
20 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
