
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. During the 2005 Special Session, the
2 legislature adopted Act 8, which created the Hawaii 2050
3 sustainability task force (task force) to review the Hawaii
4 state plan and the State's planning process, and required the
5 office of the auditor to prepare the Hawaii 2050 Sustainability
6 Plan.

7 Once all of the members of the task force were appointed,
8 the task force held several meeting during the fall of 2005.
9 The objectives of these meetings were to address and meet the
10 requirements of Act 8 and to develop and approve a process to
11 create the Hawaii 2050 Sustainability Plan. Based on these
12 objectives, the task force submitted a report to the legislature
13 outlining the process for creating the plan and making
14 additional recommendations.

15 In its recommendations, the task force noted that after
16 reviewing the magnitude of the task of creating the
17 sustainability plan, it needed more time to perform necessary
18 research and community outreach. The purpose of this Act is to



1 appropriate moneys to fund the task force, including funds for
2 the current fiscal year.

3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2005-2006, and
6 \$, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2006-2007, to provide additional funding for the Hawaii
8 2050 sustainability task force to:


- 9 (1) Conduct valuable policy analyses;
- 10 (2) Gather vital research and data;
- 11 (3) Conduct and solicit broad community outreach and input
12 from all sectors; and
- 13 (4) Launch an effective public education and media
14 campaign to educate, engage, and inspire community
15 participation.


16 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
17 office of the auditor for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


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
