# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BILL OF RIGHTS DAY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
3 read as follows:

4 "§8- Bill of Rights Day. December 15 of each year shall  
5 be known as "Bill of Rights Day." This day is not and shall not  
6 be construed to be a state holiday."

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for  
10 activities commemorating the establishment and observation of  
11 Bill of Rights Day.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
13 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
