
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007.

5 1. To be expended by the department of accounting and
6 general services:

7 A. James B. Castle high school, Oahu
8 Design, construction, and equipment to
9 expand cafeteria dining room for
10 additional student dining; ground
11 and site improvements; equipment and
12 appurtenances.




1 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
