
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE THIRD REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

 11 improvement projects authorized in this Act, shall not lapse at
 12 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 13 made; provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as
 14 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 16 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 17 designated expending agencies for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
