
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GIFT CERTIFICATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 481B-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Any restaurant or person engaged in the business of
4 offering services or goods for sale at retail may allow
5 customers to purchase gift certificates; provided that the
6 certificate issuer shall honor the certificate for a period of
7 at least two years from the date of issuance. A certificate
8 issuer shall not charge a service or maintenance fee, including
9 but not limited to a service or maintenance fee for dormancy or
10 inactivity."

11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
