A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 346-343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3	"(a) All residents of the State shall be eligible to
4	participate in the state pharmacy assistance program; provided
5	that the applicant:
6	(1) Is a resident of Hawaii;
7	(2) Is sixty-five years or older, or is disabled and
8	receiving a social security benefit;
9	(3) Has a household income at or below one hundred fifty
10	per cent of the federal poverty level;
11	(4) Meets the asset test; and
12	(5) Is not a member of a retirement plan who is receiving
13	a benefit from the Medicare Modernization Act.
14	(b) State pharmacy assistance program applicants who are
15	enrolled in any other public assistance program providing
16	pharmaceutical benefits, other than the Medicare Modernization
17	Act $[\tau]$ and Medicaid, shall be ineligible for the state pharmacy
18	assistance program as long as they receive pharmaceutical

- benefits from that other public assistance program, unless theapplicant is eligible for medicare. Residents who qualify for,

- 6 SECTION 2. Section 346-344, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "[+]\$346-344[+] Benefits. (a) For persons meeting the
- 9 eligibility requirements in section 346-343[-7] with household
- 10 incomes of not more than one hundred fifty per cent of the
- 11 federal poverty level, the state pharmacy assistance program may
- 12 pay all or some of the co-payments required under the federal
- 13 medicare part D pharmacy benefit program, subject to [receipt of
- 14 sufficient rebates pursuant to section 346-342(g), the
- 15 sufficiency of funds in the state pharmacy assistance program
- 16 special fund, as determined by the department.
- 17 (b) The state pharmacy assistance program is the payor of
- 18 last resort, subject to [receipt of sufficient rebates pursuant
- 19 to section $346-342(g)_{r}$] the sufficiency of funds in the state
- 20 pharmacy assistance program, as determined by the department.
- 21 (c) The state pharmacy assistance program shall be funded
- 22 with state appropriations [derived from revenues to the State

- 1 from rebates paid by pharmaceutical manufacturers pursuant to
- 2 section 346-342(g), which may affect the level of benefits to
- 3 program enrollees pursuant to subsection (a) depending on the
- 4 amount of the rebates received by the State to cover all program
- 5 benefits and costs of administering the program.] and revenues
- 6 to the State derived from rebates paid by pharmaceutical
- 7 manufacturers pursuant to section 346-342(g)."
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
