# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO INCLUDE ASSISTED AND INDEPENDENT LIVING HOUSING FOR KUPUNA IN ITS DEVELOPMENT PLANS.

1           WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920, as  
2 amended, was enacted to rehabilitate Native Hawaiians who had  
3 been displaced from ancestral lands by returning them to the  
4 land; and

5  
6           WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act established a  
7 land trust of over two hundred thousand acres for that purpose;  
8 and

9  
10          WHEREAS, the kuleana or responsibility for accomplishing  
11 the mandate of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act rests with the  
12 State's Department of Hawaiian Home Lands and its nine-member  
13 commission; and

14  
15          WHEREAS, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands has met this  
16 mandate through the award of over seven thousand residential  
17 leases to Native Hawaiians since its inception; and

18  
19          WHEREAS, many of those who received these leases are now  
20 elderly and are unable to live alone without assistance; and

21  
22          WHEREAS, family members often have difficulty in assisting  
23 their kupuna because meeting the financial and other needs of  
24 their own families is a hardship; and

25  
26          WHEREAS, because of advances in medical technology, the  
27 number of na kupuna living past age sixty-five is increasing;  
28 and

29  
30          WHEREAS, the availability of assisted living housing units  
31 for na kupuna are limited within the State and are non-existent  
32 on Hawaiian home lands; and

 2 WHEREAS, providing assisted living housing units within the  
 3 Hawaiian homestead community for na kupuna, living both on and  
 4 off Hawaiian home lands, will allow na kupuna living on Hawaiian  
 5 home lands who need this assistance, to continue to reside  
 6 within the Hawaiian homestead community; and

7  
 8 WHEREAS, the homes now occupied by na kupuna who need  
 9 assisted living housing units can be passed to their successors  
 10 once na kupuna are relocated to assisted living housing units,  
 11 thereby aiding family members to acquire a home on Hawaiian home  
 12 lands; now, therefore,

13  
 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
 15 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
 16 of 2006, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Hawaiian  
 17 Home Lands is requested to include assisted and independent  
 18 living housing units for kupuna in its development plans; and

 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the  
 22 Chairperson and members of the Hawaiian Homes Commission, the  
 23 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Senate President,  
 24 the Chairperson of the House Committee on Housing, the  
 25 Chairperson of the House Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, the  
 26 Chairperson of the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Hawaiian  
 27 Affairs, and the Chairperson of the Senate Committee on  
 28 Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Housing.
