
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO DETERMINE
THE FEASIBILITY OF REDEVELOPING THE OLD NAHIKU SCHOOL SITE
AND MAKING IT AVAILABLE AS A COMMUNITY FACILITY.

1 WHEREAS, the old Nahiku School located in Hana, Maui, was
2 considered a treasure by the Nahiku community and was more than
3 fifty years old prior to being recently destroyed in a fire; and
4

5 WHEREAS, due to its age, the old Nahiku School in Hana was
6 qualified to be placed on the Hawaii registry of historic
7 places; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the site currently remains undeveloped and unused;
10 and

12 WHEREAS, the Nahiku community needs a place to congregate
13 so that they may share native Hawaiian cultural practices and
14 traditions and have a central location for learning, information
15 sharing, and other community-oriented events; now, therefore,
16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
19 of 2006, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Land and
20 Natural Resources is requested to determine the feasibility of
21 redeveloping the site of the old Nahiku School, providing the
22 necessary infrastructure, constructing a replica of the old
23 Nahiku School, and making it available as a community facility;

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
27 Natural Resources is requested to consult with the Hana
28 community prior to developing its recommendations on
29 redeveloping the old Nahiku School site to ascertain the needs
30 and desires of the Hana community; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
 2 Natural Resources is requested to include any cost estimates and
 3 development time lines that are appropriate to develop the old
 4 Nahiku School site as a community center; and

 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
 7 Natural Resources is requested to submit its findings and
 8 recommendations to the Legislature not later than twenty days
 9 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2007; and

 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the
 13 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources.
