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# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO DEVELOP A  
LONG-RANGE, COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE FUTURE OF KALAUPAPA.

1           WHEREAS, pursuant to section 203(3) of the Hawaiian Homes  
2 Commission Act of 1920, Kalaupapa on the island of Molokai,  
3 comprising of 5,000 acres, more or less, is designated  
4 "available lands"; and  
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6           WHEREAS, pursuant to section 204 of the Hawaiian Homes  
7 Commission Act of 1920, available lands "shall immediately  
8 assume the status of Hawaiian home lands and be under the  
9 control" of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL); and  
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11           WHEREAS, pursuant to section 326-34, Hawaii Revised  
12 Statutes, Kalaupapa is under the jurisdiction and control of the  
13 Department of Health (DOH) and used for the care and treatment  
14 of persons affected with Hansen's disease; and  
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16           WHEREAS, within the foreseeable future, Kalaupapa will no  
17 longer be required for the care and treatment of persons  
18 affected with Hansen's disease, at which time Kalaupapa should  
19 retain its status as available lands and revert to the control  
20 of DHHL; and  
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22           WHEREAS, there is no long-range comprehensive plan relating  
23 to the future of Kalaupapa; now, therefore,  
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25           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
26 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
27 of 2006, the Senate concurring, that DHHL is requested to  
28 immediately begin the process of developing a long-range,  
29 comprehensive plan to set forth the overall future use of  
30 Kalaupapa; and  
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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHHL work in conjunction with  
2 the National Park Service, DOH, and Ka Ohana O Kalaupapa in  
3 developing a long-range, comprehensive plan for Kalaupapa; and  
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5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this long-range comprehensive  
6 plan should address the following:  
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- 8 (1) Goals, objectives, and policies for malama aina of  
9 Kalaupapa;
- 10  
11 (2) Determination of the sustainable capacity for human  
12 activity at Kalaupapa;
- 13  
14 (3) Proposed land uses, including classifications,  
15 criteria, and standards for the different types of  
16 development;
- 17  
18 (4) Protection and management of the rich prehistoric,  
19 historic, and cultural resources of Kalaupapa;
- 20  
21 (5) Protection and management of the flora and fauna,  
22 including avifauna and marine fauna, in and around  
23 Kalaupapa; and

- 25 (6) Protection of the aesthetics and natural beauty of  
26 Kalaupapa;

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30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHHL is requested to submit an  
31 interim report on the development of the long-range,  
32 comprehensive plan for the future of Kalaupapa to the  
33 Legislature, at least 20 days prior to the convening of the  
34 Regular Session of 2007; and  
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36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHHL is requested to submit the  
37 completed long-range, comprehensive plan for the future of  
38 Kalaupapa to the Legislature, at least 20 days prior to the  
39 convening of the Regular Session of 2010; and  
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41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
42 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the  
43 Hawaiian Homes Commission, Director of Health, and Director of  
44 the National Park Service.
