
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

1 WHEREAS, HRS §26-4 establishes the Department of
2 Transportation and §26-19 creates its single executive to head
3 the department who shall be known as the Director of
4 Transportation; and

5
6 WHEREAS, HRS §26-32 allows the Director of Transportation
7 to designate some other officer in the department to act on
8 behalf of the director in the director's temporary absence or
9 illness; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the same statute places responsibility and
12 liability on the director and the director's official bonds for
13 all acts done or performed by the person designated to act on
14 behalf of the director in the director's absence; and

15
16 WHEREAS, in an effort to decentralize the internal
17 processes of the department, deputies of the department have
18 been signing official department memorandum and other official
19 documents on behalf of the director, when the director is known
20 to be available; and

21
22 WHEREAS, this decentralization may call into question the
23 validity of those documents; and

24
25 WHEREAS, a management audit might uncover deficiencies that
26 could be remedied with better planning and implementation; now,
27 therefore,

28
29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
30 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
31 of 2006, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested to

1 perform a management audit of the Department of Transportation
2 to include, but not be limited to:

3

4 (1) Assessing the organizational structure of a
5 decentralized department;

6

7 (2) Assessing the benefits of decentralizing the
8 department; and

9

10 (3) Determining whether this decentralization effort
11 complies with the powers of the director and deputies as set
12 forth in statute; and

13

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Auditor is requested to submit a
15 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature
16 not later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular
17 Session of 2007; and




19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
