REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO INVEST IN A MULTIMEDIA
LEARNING CENTER EACH AT CASTLE HIGH SCHOOL AND KAILUA HIGH
SCHOOL FOR USE BY THE SCHOOLS AND THEIR SURROUNDING COMPLEX
SCHOOLS.

1 WHEREAS, access to and hands-on knowledge of information
2 technology and multimedia are components of learning that make
3 students eager and excited to learn; and

5 WHEREAS, students who are technologically literate when
6 they graduate from high school have an edge over their
7 counterparts who are not technologically savvy; and
8

9 WHEREAS, students who have acquired the tools and training
10 necessary to use information, technology, and multimedia are
11 better prepared to compete as a skilled workforce; and

13 WHEREAS, for an island state like Hawaii, information
14 technology and multimedia can help students overcome the
15 barriers of geography and limited resources; and

17 WHEREAS, multimedia centers at the local school level have
18 been a sound investment that benefits Hawaii's children; now,
19 therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
23 of 2006, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Education
24 is requested to invest in a multimedia learning center each at
25 Castle High School and Kailua High School for use by the schools
26 and their surrounding complex schools; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the
30 Chairperson of the Board of Education, the Superintendent of
